

AJ SDA Church – A/V Procedures

Camera Control

1. The remote Pan, Tilt and Zoom (PTZ) cameras are controlled from the control board the sits to the right of the vMix computer keyboard.
2. We currently have two PTZ cameras. Camera 1 is mounted over the door at the rear of the sanctuary. Camera 2 is mounted on the right-hand side wall.
3. The general procedure is to select a camera and then perform various functions with that camera until you select a different camera.
4. A camera is selected by pressing one of the CAM1 – CAM6 buttons at the left center of the control panel.
5. The digits 0-9 in the center keypad can be used to aim and zoom the selected camera to a preset position. Refer to the card near the control panel to see what presets are available.
6. The joystick can be used to pan, tilt and zoom the selected camera to aim it at the desired subject.
7. Because camera movement is difficult to control precisely, a good procedure is to move the camera that is NOT part of the live shot.
8. The remaining functions of the control panel are primarily used for setup and special functions that you won't normally use. Refer to the controller documentation for more information about these functions.
9. Please DO NOT change the camera presets as we need for them to reliably move to the documented positions.
